# Schedule of Events

## Rules

The Lowcountry Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS). Life jacket and shoes are required for each sailor.

## Eligibility & Entry

The regatta is open to all one-design class boats. Eligible boats may enter by completing the Registration Form and paying the proper fees. Registration Forms are available online at [www.byscnet.com/Sailing/lcr](http://www.byscnet.com/Sailing/lcr)

. You can pre-register on line and pay the day of the regatta. By registering all registrants agree that they will be bound by the RRS & by all other rules that govern this event.

## Courses

Courses will be windward/leeward, triangle or Olympic as described in the sailing instructions. Any course may be sailed "modified" with the signal boat stationed between the windward and leeward marks.

## Scoring

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. All races are required to be completed to constitute a series. This changes Rule A2. One race completed will constitute a regatta.

## Prizes

Trophies will be awarded as follows: 1 for 3 boats; 2 for 5 boats; 3 for 8 boats; 4 for 11 boats; 5 for 14 or more boats in a class.
